<b>1. Elective Courses:</b> If you are interested in studying Korean Language and culture, you are eligible to take Korean Language course (3 credits) and Korean Culture and Knowledge course (3 credits) offered exclusively for exchange student and it is <u>optional</u> <i>*Please be advised by exchange program coordinator in order to register for these courses at KU Sejong during course registration week</i> <b>2. KLIP (Korean Language Intensive Program):</b> If you are interested in studying Korean language during the term break between the 2 semesters (offered to the students who are studying for 2 semesters at KU Sejong), we are glad to offer a discount for our KLIP program (Application fees: waived / Tuition fee: 20% discount for 1 term). Please ask exchange program coordinator for more information.	
<b>Important Notice Regarding Courses</b> Korea University Sejong Campus has student limitation quota at each department/classes, so we cannot guarantee students will be able to take ALL the courses they wish to take. Therefore, if the students have any essential courses they need to take for graduation, we suggest them to take it at your home university. It is strongly recommended for students to make their backup plan before they apply.	

<b>How do I know what courses will be offered before?</b>	Please refer to the course list from the previous year. For example, if you are coming in Spring or Fall 2023, then you may refer to the list offered in Spring or Fall 2022. There may be little changes between the years but the list is likely to remain similar. ※ The list offered in Spring and Fall may differ so please make sure you check the relevant semester of your choice.
