**The "Kattaikkuttu Gurukulam" experiment:
Bringing together artistic, educational and social goals
to invigorate critical thinking and a more equal and humane society.**

The Kattaikkuttu Gurukulam is a residential school where 50 students (6-18 years) and 7 apprentices live, study and train together with their teachers. Our students belong to the poorest and most disadvantaged communities in Tamil Nadu, India. The artistic, academic and professional skills we equip them with enable them to break away from the vicious circle of chronic poverty they and their families find themselves in.
