

(ANTI) RACISM AND EDUCATION — TRANSATLANTIC PERSPECTIVES 2022

20.06.-21.06.2022, 09:00-15:30 *in person* at the Graduate School of Humanities, Hubland Nord

In collaboration with Flagler College, Florida, JMU American Studies and TEFL Methodology are offering students a two-day intensive WueGlobal workshop on (anti)racism and education, which will encourage participants to not just start a personal process of unlearning biases, but also deepen their knowledge of current debates and approaches to tackling racism in education.

A diversity of speakers from Flagler College, JMU, and beyond will provide transatlantic perspectives. Topics to be covered include a theoretical synopsis of racism and its continuities, discussions of "critical race theory," methods of anti-bias (teacher) training, and community activism as a form of anti-racist education.

Active participation in the workshop sessions and the submission of a writing portfolio (ca. 10 pages documenting and responding to the workshop) will be rewarded with **3 ECTS** in the "freier Bereich" / FSQ / ASQ. Additionally, participation can be applied towards both the WueGlobal and GSiK certificates.

We imagine the workshop to be of particular interest to "Lehramt" students and students with an American Studies focus.
