Steps to Apply: A guide to submitting an application to UniSC Australia

APPLICATION STEPS: Direct Enrol / Free mover students

The below instructions provide an overview on how to submit an application to UniSC via the online [International Application Portal](#).

Step	Completed By	Instruction: Direct Enrol / Free Mover Students (excludes exchange)
1	Partner Institution	Partner Institution directs nominated student to the UniSC online International Application Portal found on our How To Apply or Partner Quick Information page.
2	Student	<p>Student registers an account and begins the online application process.</p> <p>Student completes the online application portal, available on our How to Apply page. The student will be asked to provide:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">·copy of the official or unofficial academic transcript stamped/certified by the home institution. Non stamped copies will not be accepted and may cause delays·evidence of English proficiency (if not an approved first language) and;·copy of the details page of the student passport <p>In the 'notes section' of the application form the student indicates the name of their home institution which will allow the admissions team link their application to the correct arrangement.</p>
3	UniSC	UniSC will assess the application and make an offer accordingly. The offer will be sent to the student via email and the partner institution will be copied in.
4	UniSC	Diploma/Study Abroad students: UniSC will assess the student's eligibility for the courses they selected to study at UniSC. The outcome will be sent to the student via email and the partner institution will be copied in.
5	Student	<p>Student logs in to the UniSC International Application Portal, students can select their response to the offer (i.e. accept, decline or defer).</p> <p>Students can accept their offer by following the steps outlined on the acceptance page of the Letter of Offer by choosing their response within the portal.</p>
6	UniSC	Once the acceptance (and where applicable tuition fee) have been received by UniSC, UniSC will email the student the Confirmation of Enrolment (COE) document and student login details. Partner Institutions will be copied into the relevant communications.
7	Student	The student uses the CoE document to apply for a Student visa and can then enrol in their courses on UniSC Central, provided enrolment is open. Important dates are listed on UniSC's academic calendar.
8	Student	Student completes pre-departure with their home university and student then organises their study and travel plans such as flights, transfers and accommodation.

Postgraduate programs

UniSC Master programs run in Sessions, and there are various Sessions available for entry in the calendar year. However, where possible we would recommend students commence their postgraduate program in [Session 2 and 6](#).

RECOMMENDED APPLICATION DEADLINES

While UniSC does not have a published application deadline for these programs, we recommend that (where possible) applications are submitted to the UniSC International Office prior to the following dates:

- Semester 2, 2023: 30 April 2023
- Semester 1, 2024: 30 November 2023

However, we are happy to be flexible and would be able to accept applications at a later date, on a case by case basis.
