# Money Exchange

Exchange a small amount at the airport just in case SOLES are needed.

We exchange Euros. You should bring Euros or US Dollars. We recommend exchanging some at the airport. Also, VISA and Mastercard are widely accepted and used in most establishments. However, for buying souvenirs we would recommend having some cash.

Exchange at the bank or find a designated government official wearing the vests indicating they are official workers to exchange money. There are many authorized Money Exchange establishments in Miraflores and in La Molina.

# Language Requirements

Students are required to have a B2 level proficiency to take courses taught in English.

In case the student would like to take courses taught in Spanish, they will be asked to complete a Spanish Placement Test (SPT) through an evaluation in order to know their Spanish Level.


