- Applicants from Mongolia, China and Vietnam must submit the original certificate from the **Academic Evaluation Center (Akademische Prüfstelle - APS)**. You'll get further information at the the German Embassy in your home country;
- officially certified copy of the Assessment Test Certificate ("Feststellungsprüfung" of the "Studienkolleg")** with the marks received for each subject.
