ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS To be enrolled as a regular student at home university and meet the required GPA by home university.

PROGRAM DURATION One (1) semester, which may be extended to one (1) additional semester.
(Maximum 1 year)

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS Certificate a **B1 level** of Spanish as a minimum, according to the Common European Framework.

ACADEMIC INFORMATION



- 1.The internship program and thesis courses are not covered in the exchange program.
- **2.** Javeriana's **grading scale** is from 0,0 to 5,0. 5,0 being the highest score and 3,0 the passing grade.
- 3. An academic credit is equivalent to a total of 48 hours of academic work.
- 4. Full time study corresponds to an average of 17-20 academic credits per semester.
- 5. Exchange students whose first language is not Spanish are advised to take between 10 and 12 credits per semester.





- 1. Official nomination letter issued by Home university.
- 2. **Motivation letter** (1 page) stating the reasons why you want to study at Pontificia Universidad

 Javeriana.
- 3. Certificate of academic course grades (transcript of records, ToR) issued by Home University.
 - IMPORTANT: If applying for master program, please include undergrade ToR.
- 4. **Certificate of Spanish language** proficiency (level B1) for students whose first language is not Spanish and B2 English leevl to take courses in English.

5. Copy of valid passport.

INTERNATIONAL MEDICAL INSURANCE

The student must arrive in Colombia covered by international travel insurance (health/accident) according to these specifications:

- 1. That it is in the student's name.
- 2. That the dates of validity cover the entire academic semester.
- 3. Destination: Must include Latin America or Colombia or the world.
- 4. Repatriation in case of death.
- 5. COVID.

ACCOMMODATION

The University does not have student accommodation, but it does provide advice for finding accommodation in the city. The estimated monthly accommodation cost is between **USD \$200 and USD \$500**, depending on whether the accommodation rented is just a room or an entire apartment.

OTHER EXPENSES

The monthly cost for food is approximately **USD \$180**. Books, transportation and other expenses are estimated to be **USD \$70** per month.
