Joint Czech-Bavarian Research Projects 2022-2024

The Bavarian State Ministry of Education, Science and the Arts and the Ministry of Education, Youth, and Sports of the Czech Republic are inviting proposals for bilateral joint research projects between Bavarian and Czech research institutions. The programme's aim is to facilitate scientific collaboration and internationalisation as well as to encourage researchers to jointly apply for further project funding at national or EU level (e.g. Horizon Europe, Interreg, DFG-GA ČR, etc.). The programme is open to these research areas: materials science and nano technologies; engineering - electrical engineering, IT, AI, Industry 4.0, 5G technologies; medicine and health sciences; social sciences and humanities.

Funding: up to € 90,000 for 3 years.

Deadline: 31 January 2022

Horizon Europe: Increasing the Reproducibility of Scientific Results

Under the Horizon programme part "Reforming and enhancing the European Research System" this call offers funding for collaborative projects to investigate how increased reproducibility of scientific results generates gains and savings in the research and innovation process and to find, experiment and mainstream concrete solutions and best practices to increase reproducibility. Consortia must consist of at least 3 different partners from at least 3 different EU member states or associated countries.

Funding: up to € 2 million.
