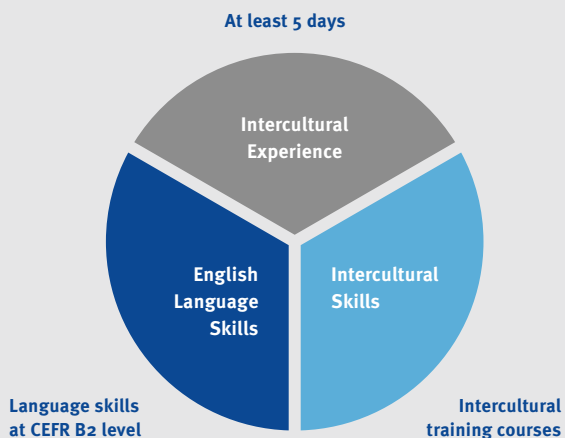
THE **UN**ivers**INTERNATIONAL** CERTIFICATE
