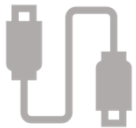




The Logitech MeetUp video conferencing camera has a built-in microphone, speaker and camera. The microphone picks up sound within a 4-metre radius.



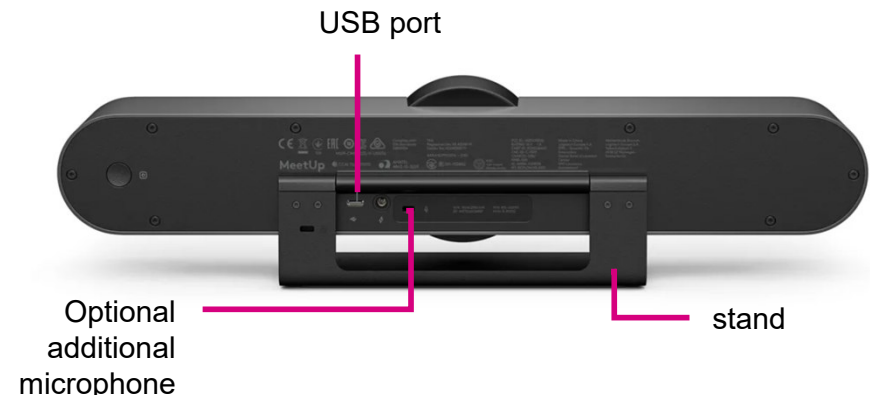
Position the camera as close as possible to eye level, directly in front of the speaker.



Connect the camera to your laptop or the computer built into the Smartboard using the supplied USB cable. Connect the camera to the mains using the supplied power adapter. If required, the external microphone can be connected to extend the recording range to up to 5 metres.



The camera is automatically detected by the laptop. In the conferencing software, you can now select “Logitech MeetUp” as your microphone and camera.





Using the remote control, you can adjust the volume, zoom in or out, pan the camera, answer and end calls, and mute the microphone.



Use the “1” and “2” buttons to set presets. Select the desired camera angle and hold down one of the buttons to save the setting.



To pair a Bluetooth device, press and hold the icon on the remote control. You can then connect via your smartphone, tablet or laptop to play music and make calls.
