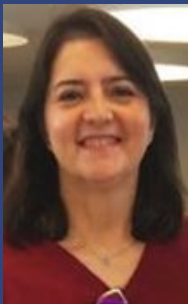

## **Managing Human Resources** **A critical review on the European Union** **guidelines and the development of** **adult education policy in Portugal** **in the last two decades**

Since 2000 the adult education and training policy in Portugal has known several developments which have shown a policy based on specific aims, innovative forms of provision, different learners joining new local adult learning and education centres. Having the lifelong learning mandate from the European Union as a central pillar and the reconversion of the Portuguese economy within globalisation as an essential feature the referred developments reveal however an ambivalent policy dynamic.

Considering changes occurred in the last two decades, a critical review on the adult education and training is fostered in this public lecture by centering the discussion on the human resources management priorities that this policy stresses and the emancipatory, social and individual development aims it neglects.
